## Hosted Service Solutions

### **1. Udemy.com**

A good option if you're starting out because they have a large marketplace that can bring awareness to your course. This online training platform can be used by instructors for free. However, Udemy makes big money by taking 50% per sale of your course. Udemy has more than 12 million students. Udemy doesn't let instructors control branding and pricing of courses.

### **2. Teachable.com**

Teachable is a paid, monthly service. They do have a free plan, but it is highly limited (no coupons, etc) and they take a high transaction fee on sales. Their affiliate program on the paid plans isn't the greatest. But the pros are that they host your videos, and it is a robust platform to get a course up quick and easy that you can fully brand, including custom domain name.
